1. COMPETITIONS

There will be **CW with Mono-Fins, CW with Bi-Fins, CW No Fins and Jump Blue Apnea** competitions.

2. INTERNATIONAL JUDGE COURSE

There will also be International Judge Course with the same payment conditions at Article 3 (no extra cost for training is charged).

CMAS International Apnea Judge Course will be starting from 2 to 09 October 2016. The course will have both Theoretical and Practical parts. The theory session will cover the details of the rules and procedures of related CMAS Apnea Competitions. The practical part will be done in the CMAS Apnea Outdoor World Championships. The successful participants will be accepted as Main Judge assistants in the competitions.

The conditions of the course as written on the CMAS web page (<http://www.cmas.org/114-28634.php?commission=apnea>) are as follows:

An International Judge's Certificate will be awarded, provided:

1. The course will be Int. Judge Course (IJC) with maximum of 3 participants from each country and/or Judge Assistant Course (JAC) with no limitation.
2. Even the candidates get the same course on the theoretical part, the candidates of each part will be responsible from their part e.g. Candidate for ICS will be responsible for all items of theory and practical but candidate for JAC will be responsible for only his/her task.
3. The course is organized under the authorization of CMAS (and CMAS Apnea Commission).
4. The instructor is a CMAS International Judge appointed by CMAS for the course.

5. The course outline has been approved by CMAS Apnea Commission prior to the course.
6. The candidates should be selected by the local federation and proposed to CMAS.
7. First theoretical training of candidate judges (CJs) will be done with the judge assistants to be used in the competition.
8. The CJs will also attend to the practical issues in a competition.
9. The instructor will follow the CJs at all phases, and it is up to him to make verbal or written exam for the CJs.
10. At the end of the theoretical and practical process the instructor will propose who has succeeded the course as the International Judge for the approval of BoD.

Finally the candidates who passed successfully the course should practice as a Main Judge assistant in the current World Championship (and/or CMAS National championship managed by an CMAS International Judge).

- Prices are **BED+BREAKFAST+LUNCH+DINNER+ALL TRANSFERS+WELCOME PACK.**
- Rooms are for 2-3 persons. If special request exists for a single room the payment will be %40 more.
- The transfers will only be done for the teams that will stay at organization's hotel.
- The ones that will not stay in the organization's hotel are subject to pay **450 Euro for participation.**
- Party night and one day cultural tour prices are, if applied, To Be Defined later on.

4. SPECIAL NOTES

1. The event is open to the athletes aged 18 and over and belonging to National Teams fully complying with the provisions of CMAS Regulations.
2. National Teams may be made up of a minimum of one to a maximum of six athletes for each men's competition and a minimum of one to a maximum of six athletes for each women's competition.
3. National Teams will have to bring with them two flags of their countries, 2x1m in size and a CD containing their national anthem.
4. Turkish Underwater Sports Federation (TSSF), CMAS, the Competition Director, Competition Officers and the Main Judge are not responsible for accidents or damage caused to people and personal effects before, during or after the competition. The organizer ensures the presence of medical assistance.
5. All participant athletes shall accept and follow the international rules of WADA.
6. Athletes must be in possession of:
 - the original entry form signed by the Federation President;
 - a valid CMAS Apnea sports licence;
 - an ID document.

Athletes that fail to provide the above documents will not be allowed to take part in

the competitions, and their participation fee will not be refunded.

7. Classifications and Prize-giving shall be performed in agreement with CMAS Procedures.

5. PROGRAMME

The Draft Program of the event is as follows:

- The opening ceremony will take place on Monday 03 October 2016 at 7 p.m., in Main Square, Kaş Downtown.
- The closing ceremony will take place on Saturday 08 October 2016 straight after the Prize-giving ceremony for the Jump Blue World Championship at the Main Square, Kaş Downtown.
- Prize-giving ceremonies will be held in Main Square, Kaş Downtown at the conclusion of each competition session.

6. CLIMATE

Kaş is one of the southernmost points in Turkey—indeed, it lies on about the same latitude with North African city of Tunis—so be ready for warm weather conditions:

7. HOW TO GET THERE

The organization will transfer you. But if you want to do your own plan; Kaş is halfway between Dalaman Airport (140 km) and Antalya Airport (192 km) and a fair distance from both, so it avoids excessive package trade. There are various ways to get to Kaş from these airports. The easiest way, and the most expensive, is by taxi. You can hire a taxi in the airport (generally more expensive - should be fixed price of 60-90 EURO), or you can book a transfer from the hotel where you will be staying or from a local travel agency in Kaş (around 60 EURO). You can take a bus or dolmuş (a shared/bus taxi of usually 12 passengers) however they stop in every small village along the way which takes more time.

There are also direct overnight bus services between Istanbul and Kaş, a rather inexpensive way of getting to and from the capital. Bus services in Turkey are very modern and generally excellent and, if you want to get to Istanbul, you may prefer spending the night in the bus and waking up in Istanbul the next morning rather than wasting a whole day traveling to the airports for a local flight.

The bus station (*otogar*) is located right at the centre of town, on the side of main square.

The savvy traveler should remember that when traveling into Kaş, there are several national holidays to keep in mind as they can cause delays in travel, traffic congestion, booked up accommodations and crowded venues.

8. GET AROUND

Kaş is a small town, and you can walk anywhere within 10 minutes. Scooters are available for rent around town (10-20 Euro per day, depending on season), if you just can't be bothered.

Minibuses run around the Peninsula of Çukurbağ, known in Turkish as *Yarım Ada*, which is a few kilometers away and where most hotels have their own terrace "beaches" open to the public (as long as beverages or food are consumed from their beach bars). Taxis to the peninsula can be costly, at least US \$10 each way.

Transportation in Turkey is excellent. You can take a minibus (*or dolmuş*) up to the village of Çukurbağ, about 10 km directly above and behind Kaş and on to places such as Kekova or Kalkan on either side of Kaş.
